### How do you enter?

  - If you submit it any other way, you will not be qualified to win.
- In the email, you MUST include the child's name, age, mailing address and phone number.
- Winners will be announced via Facebook Live on Friday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> AND winners will be notified via phone to verify their address before shipping their prize.

### Who is eligible?

• Only children that either live in Chatham County or attend school in Chatham County are eligible to win!

### What are the contest rules and restrictions?

• There are **four** age groups. There will be one (1) winner from each age group:

- **Ages 4 and Under** Bottom section can be completed by a parent, guardian, grown-up or sibling.
- Ages 5-7- Bottom section can be completed by a parent, guardian, grownup or sibling.
- Ages 8-10- Bottom section must be completed by the child.
- Ages 11-13- Bottom section must be completed by the child.
- Each child may only enter one (1) submission.
- To be eligible to win, the coloring sheet must be completed.

# When is it due?

 Submissions MUST be received via email to <u>clsawyer@chathamcounty.org</u> by 8pm on Wednesday, September 30<sup>th</sup>. Winners will be announced on Friday, October 2, 2020 via Facebook Live and winners will be notified by phone.
