


PROTECTING GEORGIA'S FOOD, FARMS, AND CONSUMERS

Food Safety and Inspection



Ensures the safety of food sold in Georgia by inspecting processing plants, grocery stores, warehouses, and meat operations.

Licensing and Regulation



Licenses and regulates agricultural businesses such as food manufacturers, pesticide applicators, fuel distributors, and animal operations.

Consumer Protection



Protects consumers by enforcing laws related to product quality, fuel accuracy, labeling, and fair marketplace practices.




Agriculture Promotion

Promotes Georgia agriculture domestically and internationally, supporting farmers and expanding markets for Georgia-grown products.



Animal and Plant Health

Oversees animal welfare, disease control, pest management, and plant industry regulations to protect farms and food supply.



Weights and Measures

Ensures accuracy in commercial transactions (like grocery scales and fuel pumps) so consumers are charged correctly.

Insurance and Regulation

Oversees insurance companies to ensure they follow state laws, remain financially stable, and operate fairly

Company and Agent Licensing



Licenses insurance companies, agents, and adjusters, verifying qualifications and enforcing standards so only authorized professionals can sell and manage insurance.

Consumer Protection

Handles complaints and disputes between consumers and insurers, helping resolve issues and ensuring policies are applied fairly and transparently.



Fraud Investigation

Investigates insurance fraud and works with law enforcement to prevent illegal activity and protect consumers.

Fire Safety Enforcement

Serves as State Fire Marshal, enforcing fire codes and inspecting buildings to reduce fire risks statewide.



Arson Investigation

Leads investigations into suspected arson cases, supporting enforcement and prosecution of fire-related crimes.

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSIONER

UTILITY RATE SETTING

Determines what utilities (like electric and gas companies) can charge customers, balancing affordability with the companies' need to operate sustainably.



Public Service Commissioner (Districts 3 & 5) are two of the many partisan primaries that will be voted on May 19th.

Early voting runs from April 27th to May 15th

UTILITY REGULATION & OVERSIGHT

Regulates electric, natural gas, and telecommunications providers, ensuring they follow state laws and deliver reliable service.



CONSUMER PROTECTION

Protects consumers by ensuring services are reasonably priced, reliable, and provided by financially sound companies.



INFRASTRUCTURE & PROJECT APPROVAL

Approves major utility projects, (like power plants and energy plans), determining how energy is generated and delivered across the state.

RULES, ENFORCEMENT & COMPLIANCE

Creates and enforces regulations, inspects company operations, and ensures utilities comply with state requirements and safety standards.

INVESTIGATIONS & HEARINGS

Conducts hearings, gathers evidence, and investigates utility practices to make informed regulatory decisions

UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ADMINISTRATION

Administers unemployment benefits, including processing claims, determining eligibility (wages, job separation), and managing appeals to ensure fair outcomes.



JOB PLACEMENT & CAREER SERVICES



Provides job matching, career counseling, resume assistance, job search tools, and access to career centers to help individuals find and secure gainful employment.

EMPLOYER SERVICES & COMPLIANCE

Assists employers with recruiting, unemployment tax reporting, and workforce needs while ensuring compliance with unemployment insurance requirements.



LABOR MARKET DATA & REPORTING



Collects, analyzes, and publishes employment data, wage statistics, and economic trends used by businesses, policymakers, and workforce planners.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT



Partners with state and local agencies to supporting training programs, apprenticeships, and initiatives that improve skills, reduce unemployment, and strengthen Georgia's workforce.
