Chatham County Police Department Files Vehicular Homicide Charge in Hit-and-Run That Killed 14-Year-Old

Chatham County, GA (January 22, 2026) – The Chatham County Police Department has filed a vehicular homicide charge in the case of a hit-and-run that killed a 14-year-old traveling on an e-bike last month.

This morning, officers with the Chatham County Police Department's Traffic Unit charged 32-year-old Miguel Reyes-Castro with felony first-degree vehicular homicide, felony hit-and-run, and driving without a license. Officers also charged the registered owner of the vehicle, 29-year-old Olvin Antonio Ramos-Ramos with felony party to a crime.

Both men were served their warrants in the Chatham County Detention Center, where they have remained without bond since they were originally arrested in connection with this case on December 29, 2025. At that time, both were charged with felony tampering with evidence and misdemeanor obstruction in connection with the case.

All charges stem from the December 28, 2025, incident where a 14-year-old was riding an electric bike in the area of Glade and Ferguson around 7 p.m. when he was struck and killed by a vehicle that left the scene. Chatham County Police Department officers recovered the vehicle involved within a few hours, and immediately began processing it for evidence in the case.

The Chatham County Police Department is the lead investigative agency in this case, and any information that comes from another source may or may not be accurate at this time.
