Chatham County Police Department Arrests Man on Multiple Child Molestation Charges

Chatham County, GA -- (May 4, 2023) — The Chatham County Police Department has arrested a man on multiple child molestation charges, and is concerned that there may be more victims of the suspect who have not come forward.

This morning, Chatham County Police Department detectives arrested 59-year-old Terry Boman, who lives in unincorporated Chatham County. Boman is charged with two counts of felony child molestation, one count of felony aggravated child molestation, and three counts of felony statutory rape. He is currently being held at the Chatham County Detention Center.

The charges against Boman involve three victims between the ages of 13 and 15. None of the victims are related to Boman, and detectives say that Boman did not meet the three victims in either a school or church setting.

Boman has lived in both Georgia and South Carolina, and detectives are concerned that there may be other victims related to this case that have not come forward. The Chatham County Police Department is urging any victims to contact them so they can receive services, and so investigative information can be gathered in relation to their case.

Anyone has been victimized by Boman, or has information that may be useful in the investigation is asked to contact detectives at 912- 651- 4717. Due to the sensitive nature of this case, and the age of the victims, the Chatham County Police Department will not have further comment or release additional details on the investigation.
