## Chatham County Police Department's Marine Patrol Announces Boater Safety Course Session Dates

**Chatham County, GA (March 21, 2022)** – The Chatham County Police Department's Marine Patrol will conduct Georgia Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Boating Safety Course sessions through September.

This is a Georgia DNR-approved class that is required for anyone that was born after January 1, 1998, who wishes to operate any power vessel or personal watercraft on Georgia waterways. The course is free and open to the public.

Class participants will be issued a Boater Education Card if they pass the exam given at the end of the class. You must have a copy of your Social Security card or know your Social Security number in order to receive the Boater Education Card.
