Chatham County Police Department Investigating Shots Fired Incident

Chatham County, GA (November 5, 2020) – The Chatham County Police Department is investigating after a shots fired incident resulted in a bullet going into a home Wednesday night.

Officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Norwood Avenue around 8:15 p.m. on November 4, 2020, where residents in the area reported hearing three gun shots. One home had a window broken and damage that appeared to come from a bullet that entered the house from the outside. No one was injured in the incident.

Additional evidence was collected at the scene. At this time, officers do not believe the homes or residents in the area were the targets of the gunfire. The investigation into the incident is continuing.
