Chatham County Police Department Identifies Person of Interest in Incidents Where Man Falsely Claimed to be Working With Police to Sell Advertising and Raise Money

**Chatham County, GA (June 23, 2021)**— The Chatham County Police Department (CCPD) has identified a person of interest in a series of incidents where a man approached businesses and falsely claimed to be working with CCPD to sell advertising to raise money for drug-awareness programs.

Officers want to speak with 23-year-old Lucas Williams in relation to the incidents.

On the afternoon of June 22, 2021, CCPD received information that a man had come into a Chatham County business claiming to be doing work for the Chatham County Police Department. The man attempted to sell the business an ad in a magazine for \$2,500, and claimed the money raised would go towards drug-awareness initiatives.

On the morning of June 23, 2021, a second business reported that a man came into their office claiming to be a representative of Chatham County Police Chief Jeff Hadley, and attempted to sell a magazine ad. In both cases, the man left without receiving any money.

The Chatham County Police Department wants to make it clear that this is a scam, and that the person is in no way a representative of CCPD or Chief Jeff Hadley.

The Chatham County Police Department is not going door-to-door, or calling anyone, regarding any advertising purchases for a police publication. On the occasions when CCPD does reach out to the community for support of an event or program, our officers are dressed in uniform, driving a marked vehicle, and provide a business card. The Chatham County Police Department does not drop in on businesses to ask for monetary donations, and the department does not sell advertising.

If you are approached by a civilian claiming to work with CCPD who is trying to sell you something or asking for a donation, please call 9-1-1.
