CEMA Enters the Enhanced Monitoring Phase for Tropical Depression 10

Chatham County, GA (August 27, 2023) – This morning the Chatham Emergency Management Agency (CEMA) entered the Enhanced Monitoring Phase as Tropical Depression 10 approaches the United States. While the path and intensity of the storm remains uncertain, this is a good time to review personal emergency plans and replenish or create an emergency kit.

As a common practice, individuals, families, and businesses are encouraged to review general storm preparation activities:

- Monitor local authorities for advice and protective actions.
- Prepare or inspect your emergency supply kit, and do not forget your pet's kit too.
- Document important belongings and consider taking pictures or video of your home.
- Inspect your property for loose, lightweight items that could become airborne.

CEMA's Enhanced Monitoring Phase activities will include:

- Monitoring the storm with each advisory.
- Sending regular updates via social media, CEMA Alerts, and posting relevant information on CEMA's Website.
