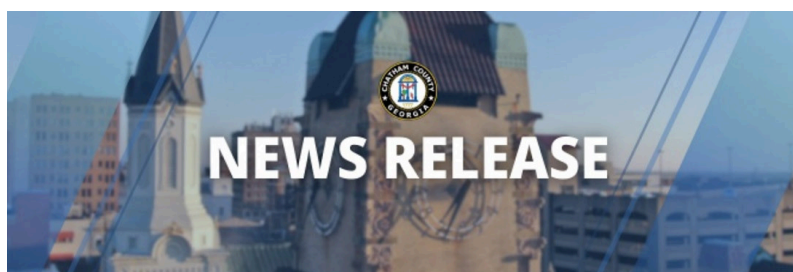

Statewide Siren Test and Severe Weather Preparedness Week February 2-6

Chatham County, GA (February 3, 2026) - This week is Georgia's Severe Weather Preparedness Week. Unpredictable weather events such as floods, thunderstorms, and tornadoes can strike Chatham County at any given moment. Chatham Emergency Management Agency (CEMA) will participate in the statewide tornado drill at 9:30 AM on Wednesday, February 4th. WHAT: Statewide Siren Test

WHEN: Wednesday, February 4, 2026, at 9:30 AM

DETAILS: At 9:30 AM Wednesday, Chatham County residents will hear a one-minute emergency tone from the various sirens located throughout the county. This monthly test is necessary to ensure that the Emergency Warning Siren System is functioning properly.

In the event of poor weather conditions such as rain or overcast weather, the siren test will be rescheduled for Friday, February 6, 2026.
