Chatham County and Local Partners to Provide Free Transportation to State Mass Vaccination Site

Chatham County, GA (March 17, 2021) – Chatham County, in partnership with local universities, faith-based organizations and non-profits, will be providing free transportation to the State of Georgia Mass Vaccination Site at Gulfstream beginning Thursday, March 18th. Individuals within Chatham County that have an appointment at the State Mass Vaccination Site and no other means for transportation can call 912-856-4563 to reserve their free transport. Transportation reservations are required by 3pm the day prior to the resident's scheduled appointment. Residents wishing to use this service are encouraged to call as soon as possible. The call center is open Monday-Friday from 8am-5pm.

Residents will need to book a vaccination appointment through myvaccinegeorgia.com prior to calling for transportation. Confirmation of the appointment date and time is required when scheduling for transportation. ADA accessible vans and buses are available, upon request, for residents that require additional assistance.

Savannah College of Art and Design (SCAD), Savannah State University, Chatham Area Transit, Isle of Hope United Methodist Church, Compassion Christian Church, White Bluff United Methodist Church, ConneXion Church and the Salvation Army are providing transportation assets and staff/volunteers to assist in this endeavor.
