CNT Search Warrant Leads to Seizure of Drugs

SAVANNAH, Georgia (February 11, 2020): An early morning search warrant leads to a narcotics seizure and an arrest.

On Monday morning, members of the Chatham-Savannah Counter Narcotics Team (CNT) executed a search warrant at a residence located in the 1200 block of West 41st Street in Savannah. The search warrant resulted in the seizure of various controlled substances to include a substantial amount of ecstasy (MDMA), crack cocaine, and marijuana. Agents also seized \$850. CNT arrested 36-year-old William "Redd" Butler of Savannah. Butler is charged with various felony related drug charges to include Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Distribute. He is in the Chatham County Detention Center.

CNT's investigation into Butler began in January after CNT was tipped off that he was selling various controlled substances to include crack cocaine and ecstasy. Throughout the investigation, undercover CNT agents made drug purchases from Butler and identified his residence on West 41st Street. At the time of his arrest, he was on misdemeanor probation.

The seized narcotics have an estimated street value of up to \$2,500. More charges are expected.
