Chatham County Public Works Receives Grant for Mass Tire Recycling Event

Chatham County, GA (March 10, 2020) – Chatham County Public Works will host a scrap tire recycling event for residents of Chatham County. This event is made possible through a grant offered by the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (GEPD).

If disposed of improperly, scrap tires are flammable, toxic and a breeding ground for mosquitoes. Recently, requests from Chatham County residents and Commissioners prompted Chatham County Public Works staff to seek grant funding for scrap tire abatement activities, as tires are not accepted in landfills and can only be recycled at a cost to the owner.

What: Scrap Tire Recycling Event

When: March 28, 2020 from 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM

Where: Chatham County Recycling Center 1321 Eisenhower Drive, Savannah, GA 31406

Details: Open to Chatham County residents. Limited to four non-commercial tires (no rims). No businesses are permitted to bring their tires to this event.
