RESOLUTION ANNOUNCING A DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY DUE TO HURRICANE IDALIA

WHEREAS, at the time of this resolution the National Hurricane Center has deemed Hurricane Idalia to be a catastrophic event with potentially life-threatening consequences;

WHEREAS, Chatham County, Georgia has the potential to experience an event of critical significance as a result of Hurricane Idalia beginning as early as August 29, 2023;

WHEREAS, in the judgement of the Chairman of the Chatham County Board of Commissioners, there will exist emergency circumstances located within Chatham County requiring extraordinary and immediate corrective or preventative actions to provide for the protection of health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Chatham County to include individuals with household pets and service animals;

WHEREAS, to prevent or minimize injury to people and damage to property resulting from this event;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by local and state law,

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that a local state of emergency exists and shall continue until the conditions requiring this declaration are abated.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That the Chatham Emergency Management Agency (CEMA) activate the Emergency Operations Plan;
- 2. That the following paragraphs of the Chatham County Code, Chapter 4, Article III, Section 1, be implemented:

1.	4-311	Overcharging Prohibited;
2.	4-312	Zoning Regulations Suspended;
3.	4-313	Emergency Business License;
4.	4-314	Registration of Building and Repair Services; and
5.	4-315	Closed or Restricted Area and Curfew during Emergency.

- 3. That the following paragraphs of the Chatham County Code, Chapter 4, Article III, Section 1, also be implemented:
 - 1. 4-310(1)(a) Grant of Authority;
 - 2. 4-310(1)(b) Request for State Assistance;
 - 3. 4-310(1)(c) Continuance;
 - 4. 4-310(1)(d)(1) Activation of the EOP;
 - 5. 4-310(1)(d)(2) Emergency Powers
 - 6. 4-310(1)(d)(3) Authority to Waive Procedures and Fees;
 - 7. 4-310(1)(d)(4) Authority to Remove Debris; and
 - 8. 4-310(1)(d)(5) Additional Emergency Powers.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Chatham County Code, Chapter 4, Article III, Section 2, Enforcement and Remedies shall also be implemented which includes:

- 1. Law Enforcement;
- 2. Penalties;
- 3. Injunctive Relief; and
- 4. Liberality of Construction.
