Chatham County Closes Facilities and Suspends Non-Essential Services at 1PM Due to Expected Severe Weather

Chatham County, GA (March 18, 2021) – Chatham County facilities will be closed and all non-essential services suspended at 1PM today due to expected severe weather.

Chairman Chester A. Ellis encouraged all residents and visitors to Chatham County to stay aware of changing weather conditions and to seek shelter as the storm approaches.

Chief Judge Penny Hass Freeseemann has declared a judicial emergency closing the J. Tom Coleman Courthouse at 1PM today as well.

Other 1 PM closures that County has been made aware of are:

- City Of Savannah offices and non-essential services
- Town of Thunderbolt offices and non-essential services
- GEMA Mass Vaccination site
- The call center for transportation for the GEMA Mass Vaccination site

Chatham Emergency Management Agency (CEMA) will be closely monitoring the storm and will be providing updates on their social media sites throughout the weather event.
