Question:	May we use a minimum use zone for surfacing and not the squared off 80'x42' available footprint?
Response:	Yes, the 80'x42' area is the existing footprint, but you do not have to use the entire area.
Question:	May we use a rolled edge on the EPDM? There was a note in the
	document stating, "a border system must enclose the protected play area". Please clarify.
Response:	Yes, a rolled edge is acceptable
Question:	For ADA accessibility, may we pour a ramp made of EPDM to transition
	from the existing grade to the new surfacing grade?
Response:	Yes, so long as it meets ADA requirements.
Question:	Will the County provide site security for the surfacing after being poured?
	EPDM requires 48-72 hours to cure and walking on it will leave footprint indentions.
Response:	The County feels that ribboning off the area will be enough to deter users
	from walking on the surface. No security will be needed.
Question:	The bid document states that components must be galvanized steel or
	aluminum. Will you accept powder coated steel on metal components?
Response:	Yes, powder coated steel is acceptable.
Question:	The park currently has a 2-bay swing with belt and a basket seat. The bid document states, "at least basket swings". Would you like a single bay
	swing with basket seats or a two-bay swing with belt seats and basket
	seats?
Response:	A two-bay swing one bay with basket seats.
