Online Motor Vehicle Renewals and Tag Renewal Kiosks in Chatham County Restored After CrowdStrike Outage

(July 20, 2024) –** The <u>Chatham County Tax Commissioner's Office</u> is pleased to announce that online motor vehicle renewals and vehicle tag renewal kiosks at Kroger and Publix are back online and available for customer use after being impacted by the CrowdStrike outage that disrupted global electronic systems on July 19<sup>th</sup>.

"We're thrilled that tag renewal services have been restored for Chatham County citizens," said Chatham County Tax Commissioner Sonya L. Jackson. "All of our vehicle tag renewal systems are back online and available to meet the needs of Chatham County citizens."

In-person motor vehicle tag renewals will be available at all <u>Chatham County Tax</u>
<u>Commissioner's Office</u> locations starting on Monday, July 22 during regular business hours.

## ABOUT THE CHATHAM COUNTY TAX COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE:

Under State law, the Chatham County Tax Commissioner is responsible for the administration of the billing and collection of current and delinquent ad valorem taxes due the State of Georgia, Board of Education, Transit Authority, Chatham County, Chatham County municipalities, and Special Service District on real and personal property as well as

mobile home taxes, public utility taxes, timber taxes, heavy duty taxes, street lighting fees, and solid waste fees. In addition, the Tax Commissioner is responsible for the billing and collection of ad valorem taxes and Title Ad Valorem Tax due the State of Georgia, Board of Education, Transit Authority, and Chatham County municipalities at the time of title application and tag renewal. Under the leadership of Chatham County Tax Commissioner Sonya L. Jackson, the Tax Commissioner's Office operates three convenient offices to serve citizens, including a Downtown Savannah location at 222 W.
