Chatham County Tax Commissioner's Office to Open New Satellite Office on Wilmington Island on Wednesday, Nov. 2

**SAVANNAH, Ga. (Oct. 26, 2022) –** The <u>Chatham County Tax Commissioner's Office</u> recently announced that a new satellite office is set to open on Wednesday, Nov. 2 on Wilmington Island, Ga. for the convenience of local taxpayers who live in the islands area.

The new satellite office will be located inside the Frank Murray Community Center at 125 Wilmington Island Rd. and will be open by appointment only every Monday and Wednesday from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

"Our new Wilmington Island office will make conducting tax and title business more convenient for the local homeowners who live in the Islands area," said Chatham County Tax Commissioner Sonya L. Jackson. "Opening a satellite office on Wilmington Island is

part of our ongoing commitment to enhance the user experience for Chatham County taxpayers and will complement our three full-service offices."

The Wilmington Island office will will join these three existing Chatham County Tax Commissioner's Offices:

#### ABOUT THE CHATHAM COUNTY TAX COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE:

Under State law, the Chatham County Tax Commissioner is responsible for the administration of the billing and collection of current and delinquent ad valorem taxes due the State of Georgia, Board of Education, Transit Authority, Chatham County, Chatham County municipalities, and Special Service District on real and personal property as well as mobile home taxes, public utility taxes, timber taxes, heavy duty taxes, street lighting fees, and solid waste fees. In addition, the Tax Commissioner is responsible for the billing and collection of ad valorem taxes and Title Ad Valorem Tax due the State of Georgia, Board of Education, Transit Authority, and Chatham County municipalities at the time of title application and tag renewal.

Under the leadership of Chatham County Tax Commissioner Sonya L. Jackson, the Tax Commissioner's Office operates three convenient offices to serve citizens, including a Downtown Savannah location at 222 W. Oglethorpe Ave. #107, a Southside Savannah location at 1145 Eisenhower Dr., and a West Chatham location at 295 Police Memorial Dr. A new Wilmington Island office, located inside the Frank Murray Community Center at 125 Wilmington Island Rd., will be open by appointment only beginning on November 2, 2022.
